WHAT IS THE JOCO PROJECT?

THE JOCO PROJECT is a Christian, home repair ministry through which volunteers repair homes for low-income families in Johnston County. Since 2012, Johnston County teenagers and adults have re-roofed, repaired and painted homes with the goal that this service will help bring about the building of God's Kingdom here on earth... specifically in our neighboring communities.

The JOCO Project is for Johnston County Church Youth Groups of various denominations and sizes, for youth who have completed grades 6-12 and college students.



HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- \$50 through May 1st or \$60 after May 1st
- This includes meals, program, t-shirt and insurance.
- A \$20 per person non-refundable deposit is due by May 20.
- Balances are due upon arrival, June 5th.



HOW DO I SIGN UP?

- A \$20, non-refundable deposit to your youth leader by May 20th
- JOCO Project Participant Form (Students under the age of 18 must have the form notarized with a parents signature) **Due upon arrival**

WHERE DO I STAY?

Groups attending JOCO Project will be housed at the First Baptist Church Ministry Center, located at 125 S. 4th Street in Smithfield, NC.

Breakfast and dinner will be provided by local churches. Lunch will also be provided at the work site by local churches.



WHAT DO I BRING?

- Bible
- Sturdy shoes or work boots
- Sturdy clothes (long pants for work!!), t-shirts with sleeves
- Work gloves & safety goggles
- Hat or visor, insect repellent, lip balm, sun block
- Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress (twin size only)
- Toiletries, towels and washcloths
- Plastic bag for dirty clothing
- Clothes for free-time and worship
- Tools—(hammer for Sr. High, paint brushes and scrapers for Middle School)
