From Your Associational Missionary

Dear JBA Family,

This month and the next are busy ones for us all as we go on mission trips and coordinate VBS schedules and then our Back-to-School activities! I will be in **Quebec** through July 7th helping out on a new church plant in Magog. We will also celebrate our annual **JoCo Project July 22-25**. In addition to these activities we will continue our **Ethnographic Research Project** looking for who are our international neighbors here in Johnston County! We have already discovered many things, such as... Most of our European immigrants are connected to our major pharmaceutical plants or with ethnic restaurants. Most of our Middle Eastern immigrants are working in businesses such as “mom and pop” gas stations with convenience food stores. All of our Chinese are connected with restaurants. Most of our Koreans are either in tailoring or dry cleaning businesses. Most of our Indians are working primarily in the hotel industry or the medical field with a few also running gas station/convenience stores. Most all Filipino and African women are nurses. All of our Vietnamese are connected to nail salons. Hispanics are found in a wide variety of employment, from agricultural and food processing, to factories and all types of construction-related jobs.

Note--This is a special time of year for our Muslim neighbors as they celebrate Ramadan (June 17-July 17). Show some interest in your Muslim neighbors by asking them about this special and unique holiday. It is somewhat tied to Abraham’s sacrificing of his son on Mount Moriah. Of course, for them, they focus on Ishmael, not Isaac, in the storyline. For more information, go to www.ncbaptist.org for some ideas about how to minister to these folk.
